I was checking a credit report late last year and saw my sister [redacted]'s, address on Cotter in Oakland California listed as one of my address's. I have had frequent address changes in the last several years but they have all been within the St. Louis area. My sister, with the help of St. Clair County asst. States Attorney Eric Rhien, has had me barred from my living mother's nursing home since shortly after my Father's death in 2001 and has placed a forwarding order on my Mother's mail to her home in Oakland. That's why I don't write my mother.

A postal clerk on Woodson Road in Overland, MO closed a paid for P. O. Box after I submitted a temporary forwarding order to the Harbor Light men's shelter in 2004.

After I saw the entry on the credit report I began to wonder if the two events were interrelated. Especially since I have first hand knowledge that my sister will pay for evidence in a civil case. When she took me and my mother to a Chevy's restaurant in O'Fallon shortly after my Father's death and noticed what she described as a dearth of black employee's, my sister [redacted], told me she would pay me \$40 to fill out an application, not get hired, to possibly form the basis of a lawsuit. At the time I believed, and continue to believe, my Sister wanted information about me, via the application, for whatever reason.

And if I am still entitled to an opinion, the postal inspection service and the F.B.I. in St. Louis ain't shit!
